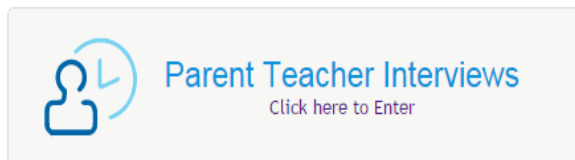

Wearing my Bulldogs shirt shows my friends which team I go for. They wear their footy team colours too.

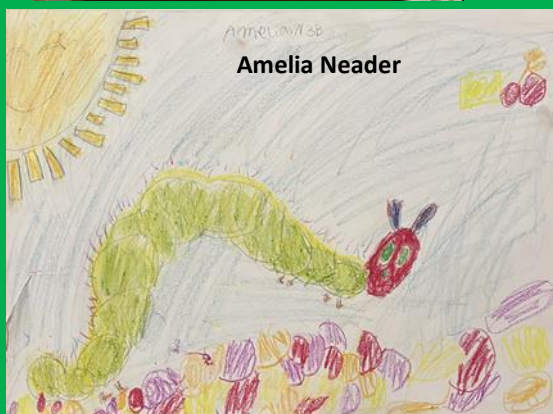
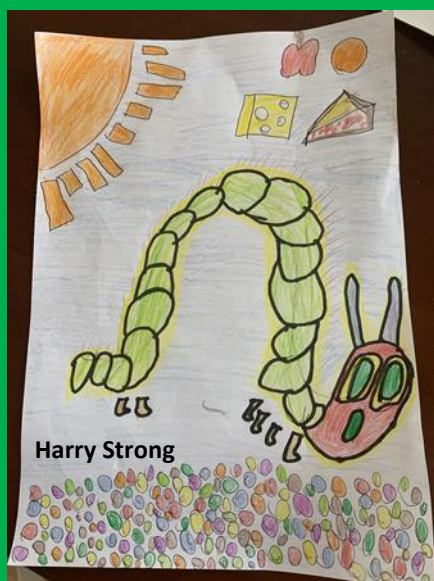

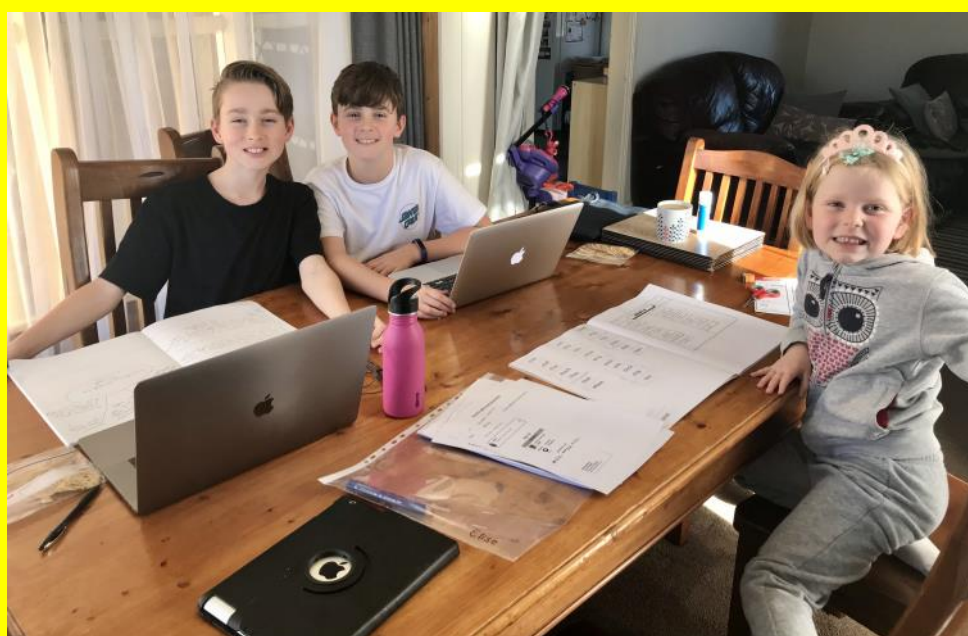

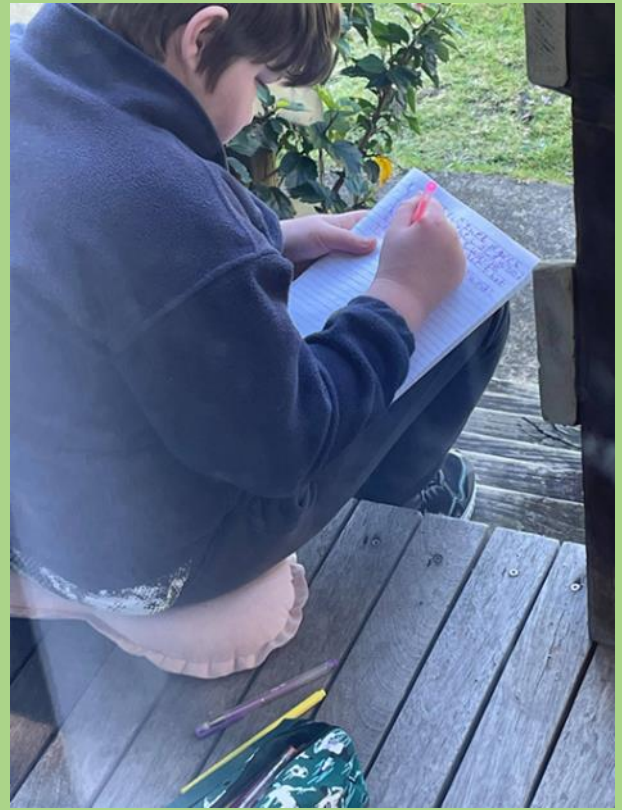

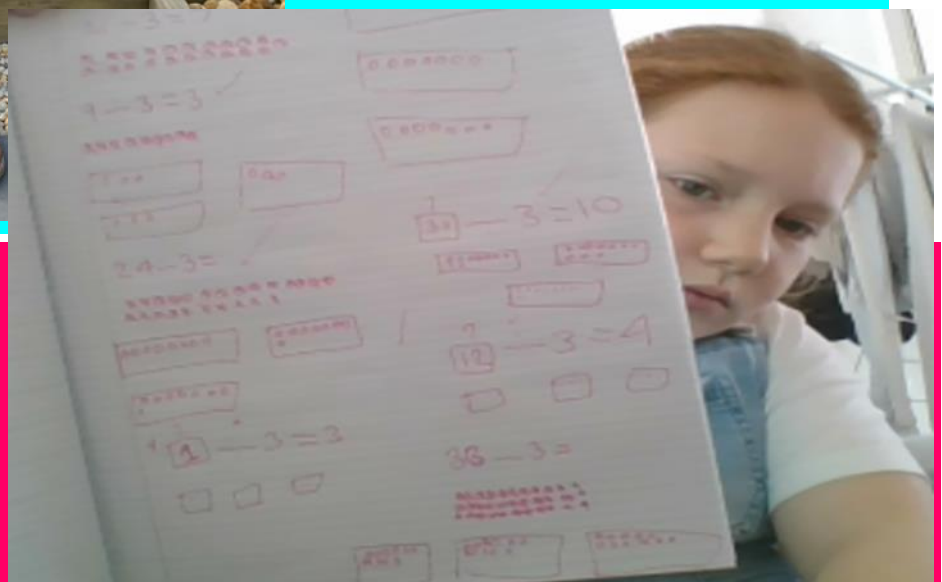

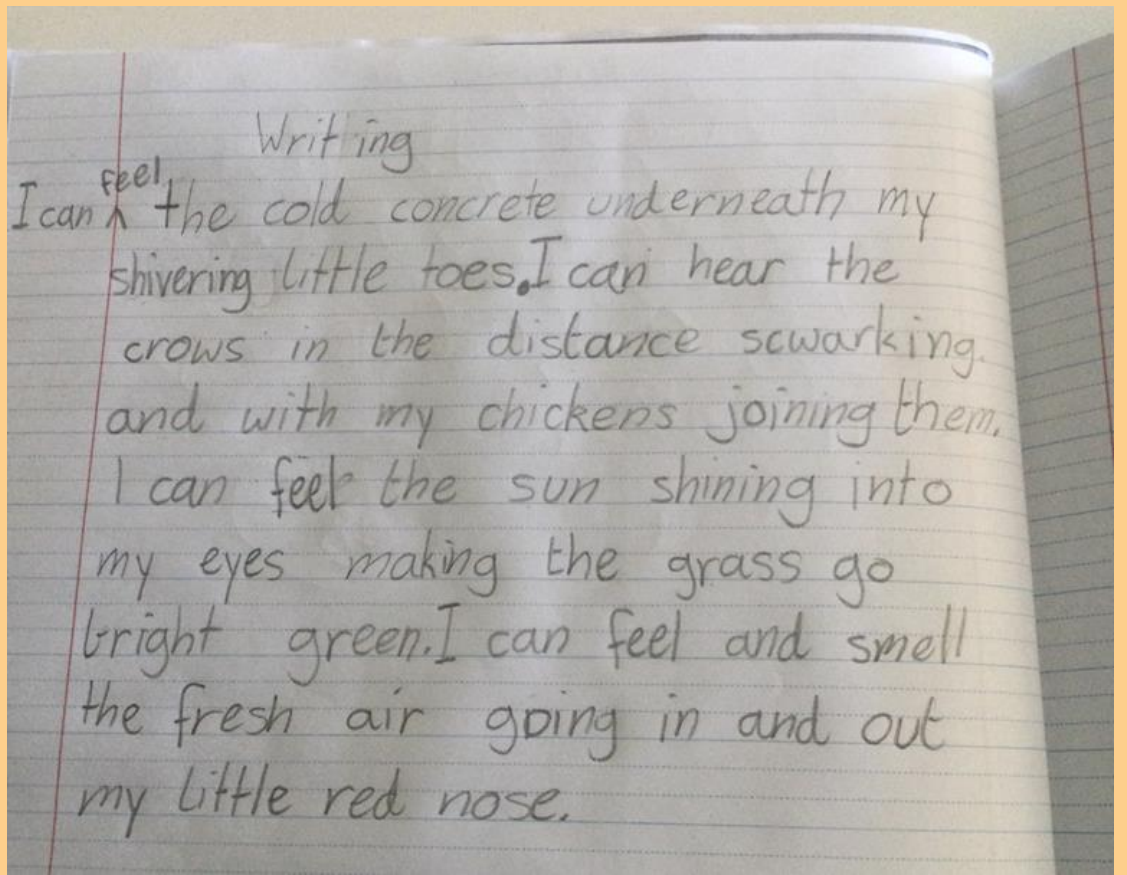
