Even when you're doing something fun with your child, she still might behave in ways you don't like. For example, she might complain about the game you're playing or demand to be go home because she's bored.

Children behave in challenging ways for many reasons. If your child misbehaves, try to **work out why** he's acting up. For example:

• Are your expectations realistic? For example, maybe a game is too hard, or your child can't concentrate on it for that long.

• Is your child getting tired or bored? If it's a long outing, your child might have had enough. You might just need to try something else, or it might be a sign to stop the activity and try again another time.

• Does the activity suit your child's temperament? Some activities suit different temperaments better than others.

If your child misbehaves during time together, you could use it as a chance to guide your child towards better behaviour, or teach your child a skill. For example, you could show your child how to fold a t-shirt, catch a ball or do a collage. Or you could help her learn how to stop, walk away and calm down when she's feeling frustrated.
