What if your child misbehaves during 'fun' activities? Even when you're doing something fun with your child, she still might behave in ways you don't like. For example, she might complain about the game you're playing or demand to be go home because she's bored.

Children behave in challenging ways for many reasons. If your child misbehaves, try to **work out why he's acting up**. For example:

- Are your expectations realistic? For example, maybe a game is too hard, or your child can't concentrate on it for that long.
- Is your child getting tired or bored? If it's a long outing, your child might have had enough. You might just need to try something else, or it might be a sign to stop the activity and try again another time.
- Does the activity suit your child's temperament? Some activities suit different temperaments better than others.

If your child misbehaves during time together, you could use it as a chance to guide your child towards better behaviour, or teach your child a skill. For example, you could show your child how to fold a t-shirt, catch a ball or do a collage. Or you could help her learn how to stop, walk away and calm down when she's feeling frustrated.

On Friday, 30 July our school will celebrate the official Blessing and Opening ceremony at 9.30am of our new buildings. Special guests include Bishop Greg Bennet, Maria Kirkwood and government officials. Unfortunately, due to recent COVID restrictions only a limited number of guests can attend.

Tomorrow our school AFL football team and two of our soccer teams will compete in the Division Winter Sports in Bairnsdale. Parents are welcome to attend as long as they follow the COVID requirements at each site. AFL football is held at the Wy Yung ovals and soccer is at the West Bairnsdale ovals. Good luck, teams!

BOOK FAIR 2021

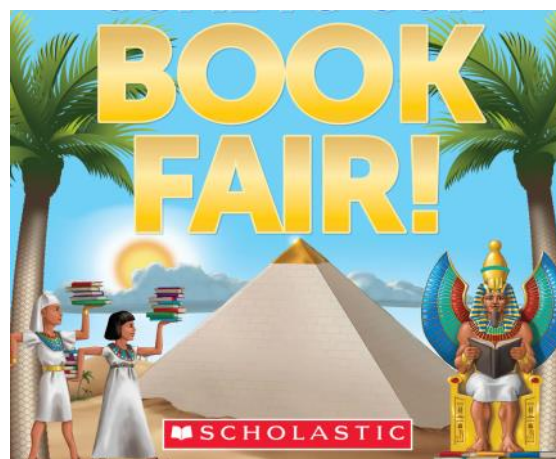

Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and St Brendan's is excited to be participating. The PRC application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs)
- a modern user-friendly interface
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved

the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 17 September 2021.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

The Premiers Reading Challenge has an online recording system which is intended for students to enter their books at home.
