Term 3 Remote Schooling Extended

St Brendan's Catholic Primary School will be closed during **Wednesday, 21 July 2021 to Tuesday, 27 July 2021 (inclusive)**, but will stay open for students in the following categories:

students of parents, guardians or carers considered an essential worker who cannot work from home

- where there are two parents, guardians or carers, **both must be essential workers**, working outside the home
- for single parents, guardians or carers, the essential worker must be working outside the home

vulnerable students including:

- children in out-of-home care
- children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm
- children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service)
- children with a disability who cannot learn from home due to vulnerability or family stress.

Face masks must be worn by all people aged 12 years or older indoors and outdoors.

Parents, please note we are experiencing requests for students to attend from families who do not meet the above criteria. If you are at home and can supervise you children then that is what the government is asking you to do.

If your child has borrowed a computer for Remote Learning, **it is important that it is returned on their first day back at school.**

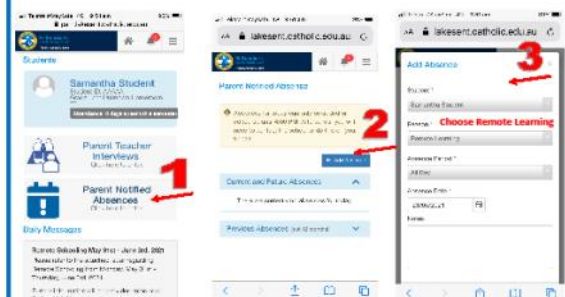
Please return computer and charger cord in the bag supplied clearly marked with your child's name.

Remote Learning Attendance

By law, all students need to be present or accounted for every school day. School is still required to monitor student attendance.

- Parents will be required to mark your child's attendance via PAM
- If your child is sick or will not be participating you will need to fill out a Parent Notified Absence.



The attendance/absentee will need to be submitted before 10.00am, school days, Monday to Friday.



If the school has not been informed of the attendance or absentee a text message will be sent to your mobile. If this text is received, please follow up by logging on to PAM and submitting an absence or remote learning attendance.

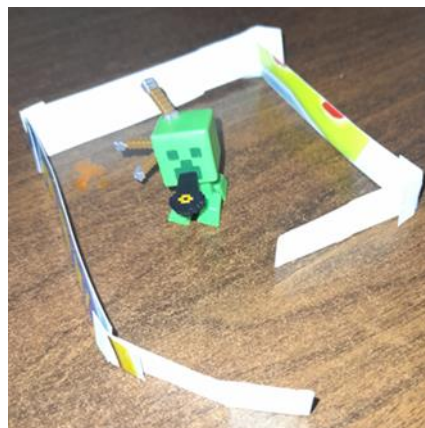
Remote Learning

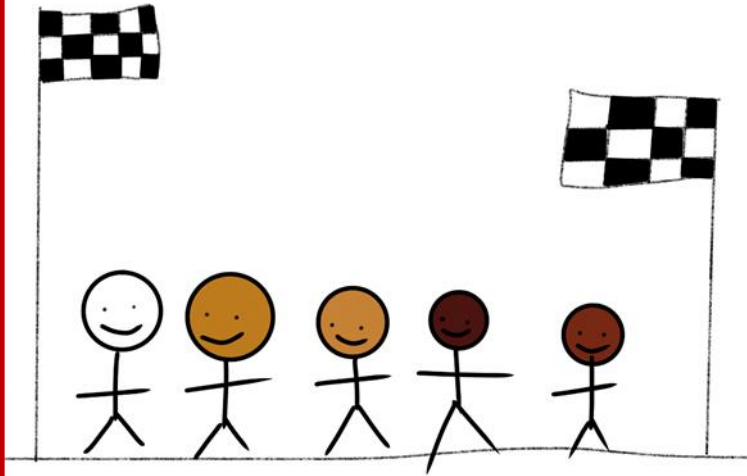



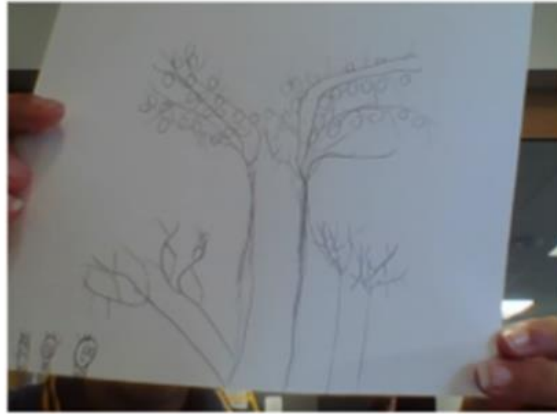

Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and St Brendan's is excited to be participating. The PRC application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs)
- a modern user-friendly interface
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved

the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 17 September 2021.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

1. QR Code Service :
