Dear Families and Friends,

Well, we are working through another tricky period of time. Thank you all for your help and understanding. We may need to get used to snap lockdowns and snap returns as the government aims to differentiate restrictions. At the end of the day, we will be doing everything possible to make sure the students can access the curriculum. Once again, they have returned in positive fashion, happy to see their teachers and mates and keen to readjust to the routine in the classroom.

Great news last week, with our **AFL team and our girls' soccer teams** making it through to the Regional level of competition on Wednesday, 25 August. I am told this is only the second time for the AFL team to make it through and the first for soccer. Very exciting!

At this stage of restrictions parents are not allowed to come to school. If parents do need to drop their children to the classroom in the morning or to collect from the office, please remember to wear masks. We hope that assemblies, Masses, etc will return soon. We are pressing ahead with the **Year Six Play**. If visitors cannot attend we will record the play in front of a school audience. Our **Year Five camp to Sovereign Hill** is still being prepared with the hope that it too will be allowed in week 10.

### Why talking about school is important

- Talking with your child about the school day **shows you're interested** in what's going on in his life. This interest boosts his mental health, happiness and wellbeing. It can also have a very positive effect on your child's behaviour and achievement. It shows your child that you value school and education, which encourages him to value it too.
- Talking together about school also **helps you get to know more about what's expected of your child at school**, how she learns and how she handles challenges. It can help you understand when she's feeling less interested in school or having problems.

#### Strategies for talking about school with your child

- Your child will probably be tired and hungry or thinking about other things when she first gets home. So easing the transition from school or after-school activities to home can help your child feel more like talking.
- It's best to avoid asking him lots of questions straight away. You can just let your child know that you're glad to see him, and talk about non-school topics for a while. Younger children will probably also like unpacking their bags and going through any notes before you ask about school.

We are hopeful that **District Athletics** will go ahead on the back-up day set for Thursday, 19 August. A number of schools are trying to get their own carnival completed before it can go ahead. St Brendan's hosts this event at Howitt Park in Bairnsdale.

**NAPLAN results** are expected to arrive sometime this month. Parents of students in years three and five will receive a letter with the results. We are looking forward to analysing the school data as we are expecting positive growth.

Whilst in home schooling it's important that you enjoy yourself, cooking is a fun activity you can do as a family or individually. Here is an easy apple cake recipe that you can cook!

### Easy Apple Cake

Ingredients

2 cups of self raising flour

3/4 cup of castor sugar

3 apples, peeled, cored and cut into little pieces

125g butter

1 egg

Cinnamon ground

- Step 1- Preheat oven to 200c (180 fan forced)
- **Step 2-** Toss apples with self raising flour and castor sugar in a medium bowl and mix.
- Step 3- Melt butter in a small saucepan on the stovetop. Allow it to cool, then stir in the egg.
- Step 4- Pour the butter and egg into the apple mixture, add enough cinnamon to your liking and mix until combined.
- Step 5- Spoon into a lined slice tin. Then sprinkle some cinnamon onto the top of the mixture.
- Step 6- Bake for 35 to 40 minutes or until the top is golden brown and a skewer comes out clean.

Feel free to experiment with it, you could add different fruits instead of apple (e.g. pear)
