

4 SQUARE METRE RULE AND DOUBLE VACCINATED—Everyone has been keenly anticipating our economy opening up and provision for visiting loved ones again. However, with that comes some anxiety now that we are moving towards a 'COVID-normal' society. Our churches will be open according to the State government requirements of the 4 square metre rule and double vaccination. St Brendan's church will have a cap of 70 for Mass and 20 at St Joseph's, Swan Reach. St Colman's will have a cap of 50 and 20 at St Dymphna's, Buchan. St Peter's Mallacoota will have a cap of 24. Until the mandated division is removed, a Mass for parishioners of East Gippsland who are not yet double vaccinated, or prefer not to reveal their COVID vaccination status, can be arranged, based on requests. Face Masks – Primary Students

There is a requirement for students in Years 3 to 6 to wear a face mask indoors at school, **unless a lawful exception applies**. Whilst not required, it is strongly recommended that students in Foundation to Grade 2 wear a face mask indoors at school.

Some of the expectations for face masks at school are:

- A face mask must cover the nose and mouth. Face shields, scarves or bandanas do not meet these requirements
- Face masks can be of different colours/patterns. To help reinforce our educational practice we would prefer masks not be disposable
- All face masks must be labelled with student's names
- Students are not required to wear masks at play or during sport
- Masks to be stored in the front pocket of student's bags when not in use
- Students encouraged not to handle masks. Hygiene education provided by teachers to reinforce appropriate behaviours



Wellbeing and Resilience

As part of my Wellbeing role, I am available to meet with children on a regular basis to talk about any issues or concerns they might have and to discuss some strategies that could help.

The sessions are delivered to individuals or in small groups of 2-4 children, depending upon need. The sessions aim to build self-esteem and an awareness of feelings and emotions. We do this through discussion, art, mindfulness and meditation.

I am also trained to run the *Seasons for Growth* program. This is a grief and loss education program that draws on the metaphor of the seasons to understand the experience of grief. It builds the knowledge and skills necessary to strengthen social and emotional wellbeing following significant loss by:

- · exploring the impact of change and loss
- · learning about effective ways to respond and adapt
 Participants learn that they are not alone in their
 experience of change, loss and grief, and are able to build
 their communication, decision making and
 problem-solving skills within the context of a safe and
 supportive peer group learning environment.


