RE: Vaccination Requirements to Enter School Grounds


DOSCEL schools have been advised that due to COVID-19 restrictions all visitors entering school grounds must comply with vaccination requirements, density limits, face mask requirements, QR code check-ins and practise respiratory etiquette and good hand hygiene.

Therefore, all eligible adults who wish to enter school grounds must be fully vaccinated, unless an exemption applies.

St Brendan's CPS is compiling a Visitor Vaccination Certificate register. When visiting school please allow supervising staff to view a copy of your certificate. We apologise in advance, if you are asked on more than one occasion to present your certificate. However, the management of this requirement is going to be complicated.

PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS

Customers aged 16 or over must show proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a signed medical exemption as a condition of entry to most businesses. Here is what is accepted:

Face Masks – Primary Students

There is a requirement for students in Years 3 to 6 to wear a face mask indoors at school, **unless a lawful exception applies**. Whilst not required, it is strongly recommended that students in Foundation to Grade 2 wear a face mask indoors at school.

Some of the expectations for face masks at school are:

- A face mask must cover the nose and mouth. Face shields, scarves or bandanas do not meet these requirements
- Face masks can be of different colours/patterns. To help reinforce our educational practice we would prefer masks not be disposable
- All face masks must be labelled with student's names
- Students are not required to wear masks at play or during sport
- Masks to be stored in the front pocket of student's bags when not in use
- Students encouraged not to handle masks. Hygiene education provided by teachers to reinforce appropriate behaviours


BOOK FAIR 2021



Class by Class Book Fair - Previews/Payments


- Preview with students one class at time. (compulsory handwashing before and after sessions)

- We can accept cash. Please send correct amount to school in an envelope clearly marked with child's name, class and books/items required.


Thank you for your understanding, we really benefit from holding the fair as we replenish the library with new books from the commission we earn.



Wellbeing and Resilience

As part of my Wellbeing role, I am available to meet with children on a regular basis to talk about any issues or concerns they might have and to discuss some strategies that could help.

The sessions are delivered to individuals or in small groups of 2-4 children, depending upon need. The sessions aim to build self-esteem and an awareness of feelings and emotions. We do this through discussion, art, mindfulness and meditation.


I am also trained to run the *Seasons for Growth* program. This is a grief and loss education program that draws on the metaphor of the seasons to understand the experience of grief. It builds the knowledge and skills necessary to strengthen social and emotional wellbeing following significant loss by:

- · exploring the impact of change and loss
- · learning about effective ways to respond and adapt

Participants learn that they are not alone in their experience of change, loss and grief, and are able to build their communication, decision making and problem-solving skills within the context of a safe and supportive peer group learning environment.
