



A Reminder: Students may only attend the book fair before or after school if they are with their parents or have the money to purchase items.

If you are unable to attend the Book Fair, please utilise the Wish List prepayment option:

- Students complete **wish lists** and take them home.
- Parent decide what they would like to purchase, pays by Credit Card online and **write receipt number on Wish list** or print the receipt to pdf or take a screen shot with receipt number and email to kwykes@lakesent.catholic.edu.au. (Emails need student name, class , books wanted and receipt number).
- Child return to school with completed **wish list** to collect book (or a reorder is placed if stock is sold).



The form consists of two parts. The top part is a 'RECORD YOUR PAYMENT RECEIPT NUMBER BELOW' section. It includes fields for 'Receipt Number' (a 16-digit barcode) and 'Amount Paid'. Below this is a 'My Wish List' section with fields for 'Child's Name', 'Teacher', and 'Class'. It also has a table with columns for 'TITLE', 'LOCATION', and 'PRICE'.

If your child brings home a Book Fair Wish List and you want to pay for these selections by credit card in advance, please:

1. Go to scholastic.com.au/payment
2. Click 'Book Fairs'
3. Enter amount and pay
4. Record receipt number on back of Wish List
5. Your child then takes this payment record back to school, chooses books at the Fair and takes receipt number to cashier as payment.

Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and St Brendan's is excited to be participating. The PRC application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs)
- a modern user-friendly interface
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved
- the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 2nd September 2022.

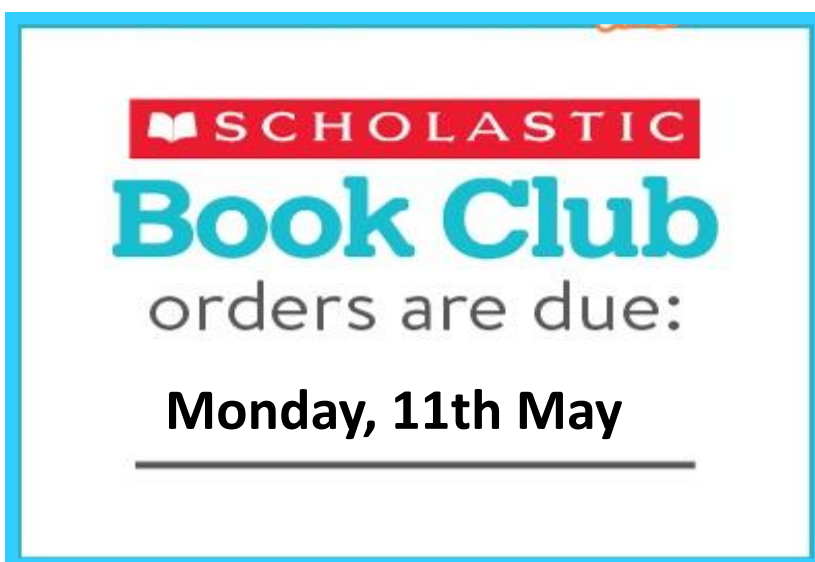
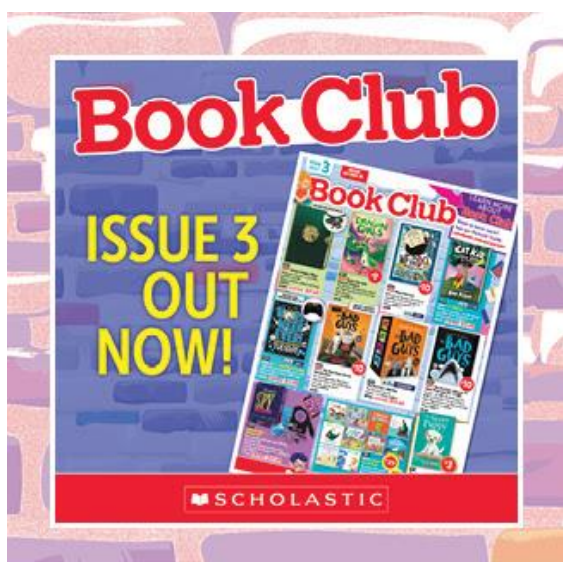
Children from Foundation to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

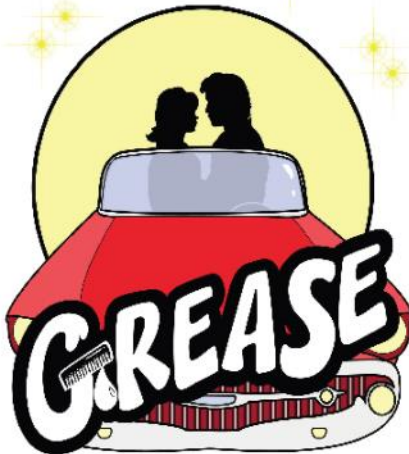
