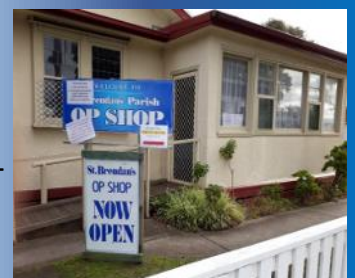

The aim of the LBDC is to develop ideas and skills that inspire further scientific exploration, discovery and learning.
